The silver, in clay form, can be molded, shaped, stamped, carved and cut to create original and unique wearable art! This 6 hour beginner's class will provide a complete hands-on experience working with metal clay from beginning to finished silver jewelry you can wear home! Classroom tools are provided. Additional clay, findings, and take-home tools will be available for purchase from the instructor. Bring a sack lunch and your sense of fun!

Marvelous Silver Beads Linda Stiles Smith

If beads are your passion – then learn to make your own unique silver beads! We will have a full day to create 3 different styles of beads in metal clay. You will learn how to use a bisque bead as a form for silver. Go tubular with straws and rolled metal clay to make long and lean silver beads. Fashion your own bead caps and spacer beads to rival mass produced ones. Explore different forms of metal clay to design your own special beads. Making your own beads helps you to create jewelry that really stands out from the crowd.

Materials fee includes 10grams silver lump clay, 10g paste, 1 sheet of paper type clay, 3 bisque beads – enough to make 10-15 beads! (Includes use of my syringe type clay) Additional clay and tools will be available for purchase from the instructor. As many beads as possible will be fired in class, but some may need to be fired and mailed to the center for pick up.

You will be using Traditions Resin Acrylic paints. In this class you will be using 9 colors and mixing the rest of the colors that we will be using. You will be painting two canvases. You will need to have 2 12" X 14" stretched canvases. Please try to get the smoothest feeling canvas you can find.

The first 4 week class will be a painting called "Country Lane". The second 4 week class is called "Reflections". The painting samples will be on display in a couple of weeks.

Prep: To be done before class: If you can't find a very smooth canvas please gesso your canvas to get it smooth. Using several thin coats is better than one very heavy coat. Be sure to let the gesso dry well between each coat. Lightly sand with 220 grit sand paper between each coat.

Supplies wet palette, wax palette, blue shop paper towels, stylus, water basin, small water bottle to mist palette, 220 grit sand paper, grey and white graphite paper, tracing paper(at least 11 X14) and eraser(gum eraser if you have one), Palette Knife
Brushes used: #6 filbert, #8 filbert, #3 round, #1 liner and a 3/4" wash brush.
