Theme 50 Years of Space

Eligibility

Open to all artists – Domestic and International. Original artwork only; must be original in concept design and execution. Copies of other artwork or published photographs are not acceptable. Artwork must be created by person entering.

Age Groups

- 0 – 5 years of age by December 1
- 6 – 12 years of age by December 1
- 13 – 17 years of age by December 1
- 18+ years of age by December 1

Entry Requirements

- Submit by December 1 (in person or postmarked no later than December 1)
- Artwork must be 4 x 6
- Art work must be adhered to a 5 x 7 piece of black construction paper
- Label front bottom right corner with:
 - o Title
 - o Name
 - o Age Group
- Print the entry form and place it on the back

Prizes

The winning artwork will be printed on notecards and postcards that will be sold at the Riverside Art Center and the Armstrong Air & Space Museum. In addition, there will be a prize package for the top entry in each category including year memberships to the Riverside Art Center and the Armstrong Air & Space Museum.

Proceeds

Proceeds from the sale of the items will benefit the Riverside Art Center and the Armstrong Air & Space Museum.
